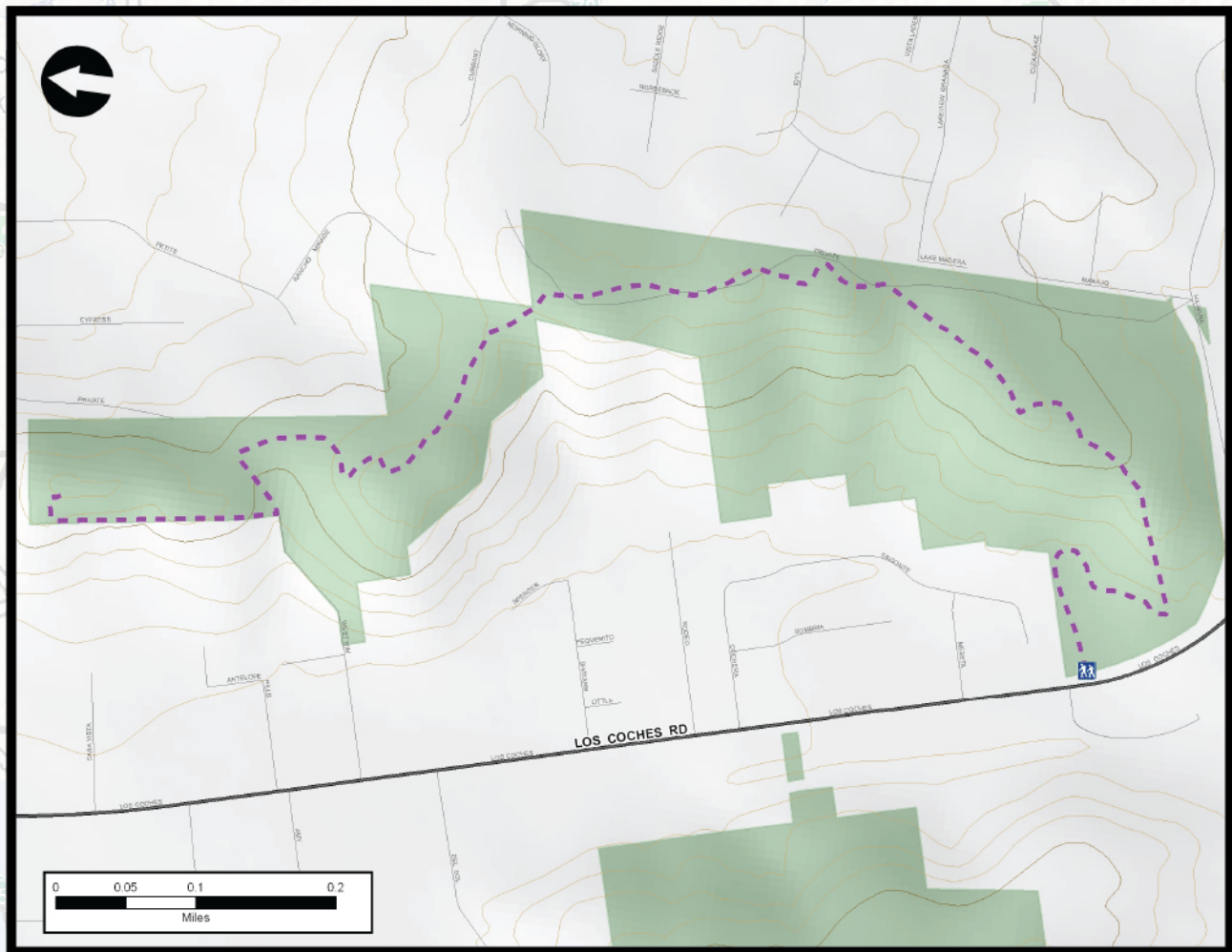

Lakeside Linkage Preserve consists of a very high value natural community – coastal sage scrub. This vegetation community supports several sensitive species including coastal California gnatcatcher, coastal cactus wren, and orange-throated whiptail.

A 1.3 mile trail leads to the Whitaker House, a well-known Lakeside landmark, that is located within this Preserve. A native moss-faced stone building located on a hill within the central property of the Preserve, the Whitaker house is a significant structure for its architectural integrity and style as a vernacular residence, as well as its local meaning to the citizens of Lakeside and for the possibilities that its open space and vistas provide.
